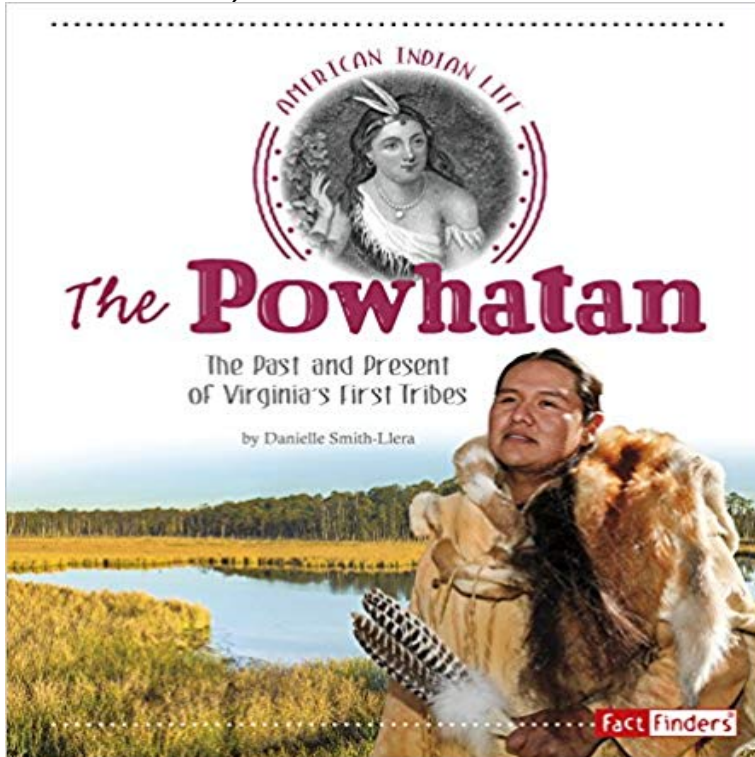


The Powhatan: The Past and Present of Virginias First Tribes (American Indian Life)
