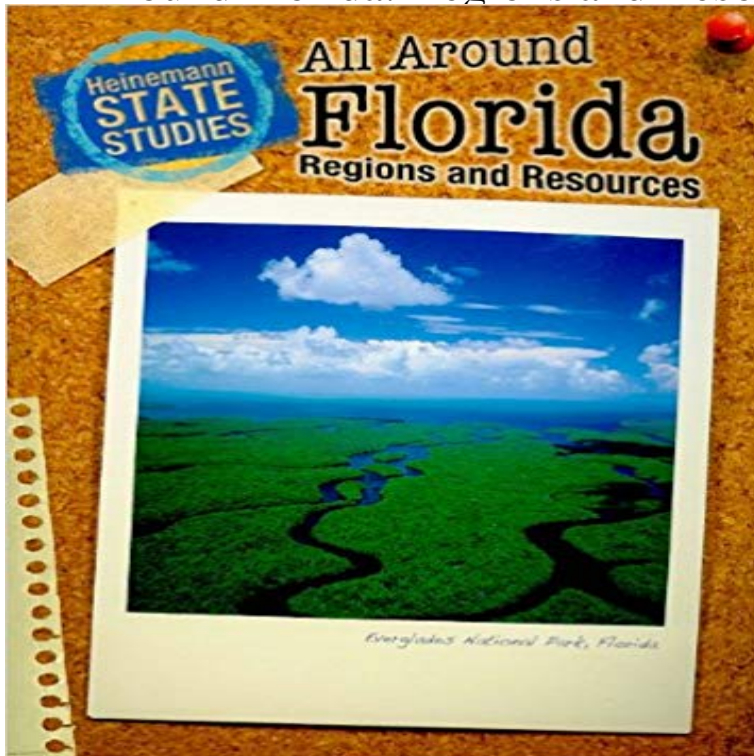


All Around Florida: Regions and Resources (State Studies: Florida)
