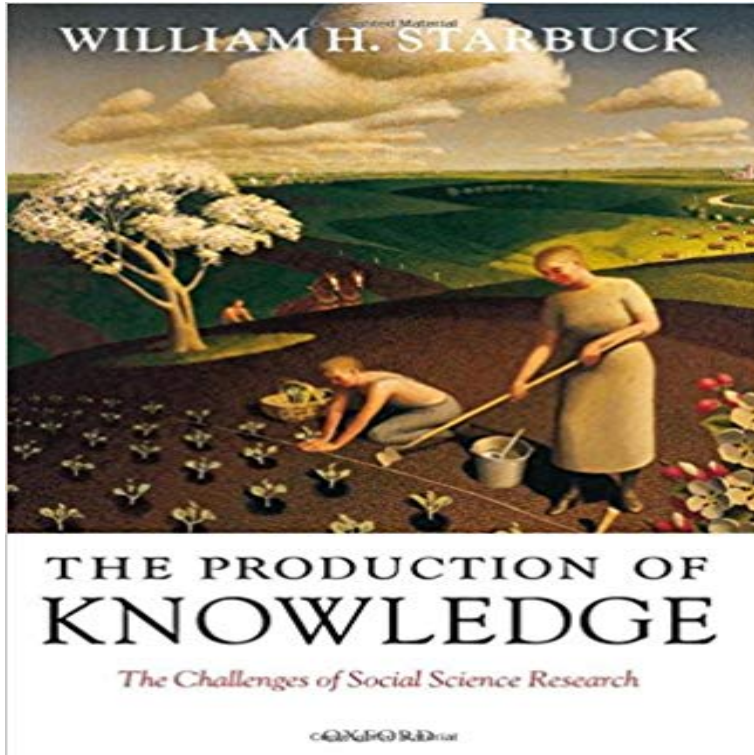


The Production of Knowledge: The Challenge of Social Science Research
